The City of Fairfield in conjunction with the City of Benicia propose to repair Lopes Road, a Fairfield potable water line, and a Benicia non-potable water line, all of which sustained damage from a landslide. Geology stabilization is also proposed in the project area to reduce exposure to future landslides in the area.
