DODDS ROAD AND HENRY ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT

Project Description

Project Location:

Dodds Road: Henry Road to 500 feet east of the Dodds Road and Henry Road intersection. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

Project Justification:

A fatality occurred at the Dodds Road and Henry Road intersection in May of 2021. The intersection has also had a handful of less severe collisions between 2002 to 2022. The jog in the road has been identified as a potential factor in many of these collisions. Therefore, a minor roadway realignment for eastbound traffic to meet current standards is being implemented as a preventative measure.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

1. Widening the south side of Dodds Road east of the Henry Road intersection.

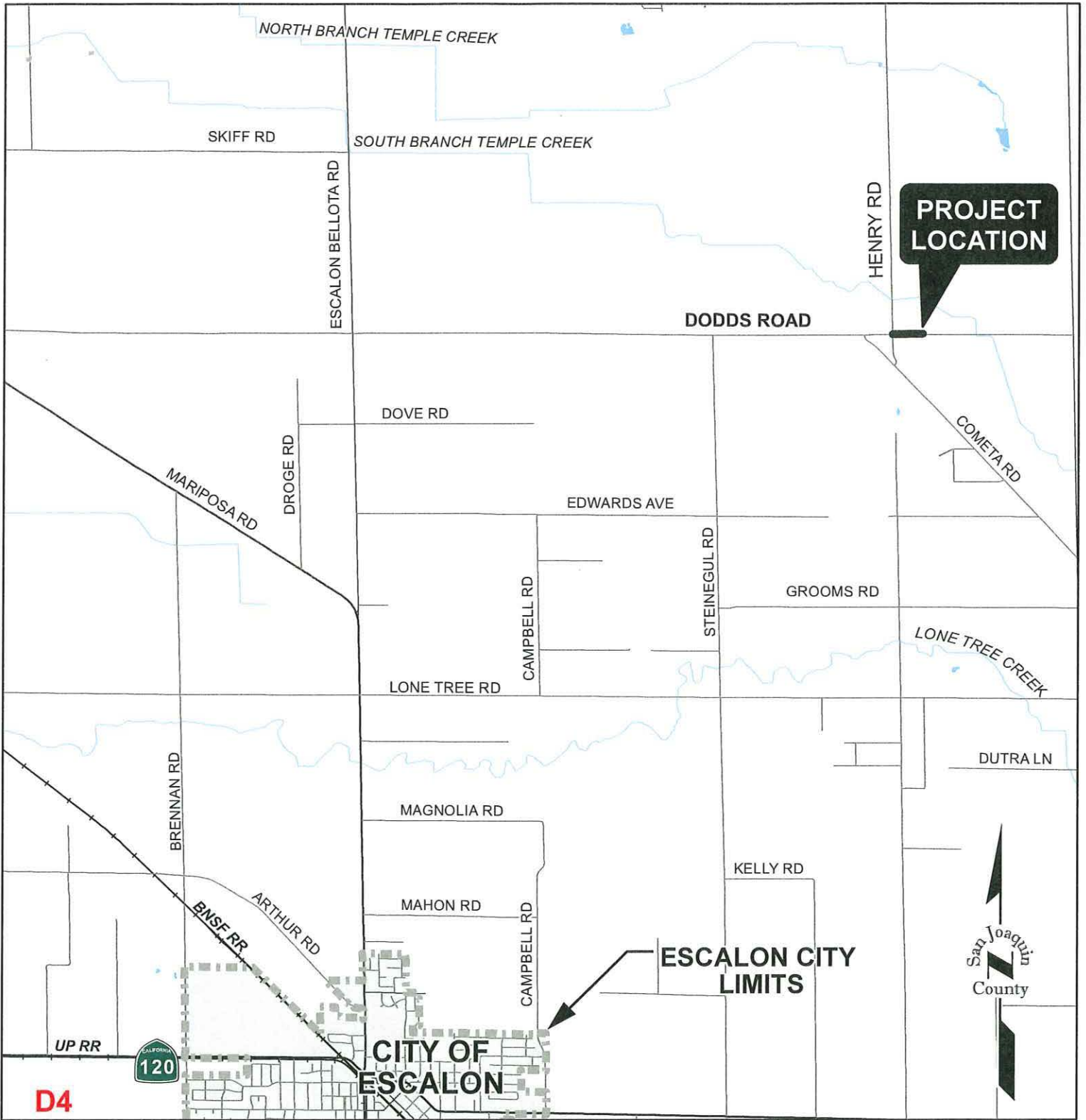
Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes.**

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
