Project Title: 2023 HSIP Systemic Roadway Segment Improvements

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Project includes the installation/upgrade of signs with new fluorescent sheeting (regulatory or warning) and the installation of chevron signs on horizontal curves, and the installation of delineators, reflectors, and/or object markers along the road segments listed above. Signage will be added along 56.1 miles of roadways. Construction will be entirely within the existing County right of way, take place during the summer, and be completed during a single construction season. Beneficiaries of the project are the traveling public.


