Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located on the waterside berm of the Sacramento River within Reclamation District 1000, approximately 0.2 miles upstream of the Riego Road and Garden Highway intersection in Sutter County at 38.75242°N 121.59299°W, Sacramento River.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To authorize an existing 30-foot by 22-foot detached structure with a garage on the first floor and workshop on the second floor, approximately 6 feet of underground electrical conduit, and replacement of an existing electrical junction box on the left (east) bank levee of the Sacramento River.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Board has determined that the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15301), because the activity consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use. No expansion of existing or former use will occur. The project is also exempt from CEQA under the Class 2, Replacement or Reconstruction categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, 15302), because the activity consists of replacement and reconstruction of an existing structure in the same site and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the replaced structure. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
