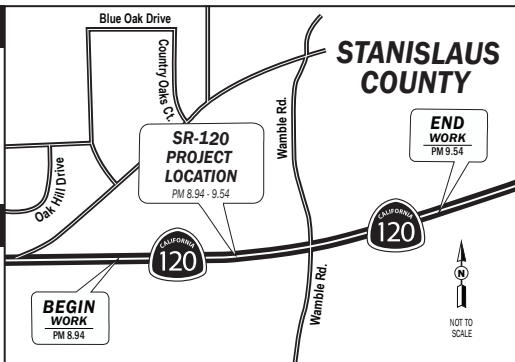
Wamble Road Left-Turn Channelization Project

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from October 30, 2024, to December 2, 2024. If there are no major comments or requests for a public hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to install left-turn channelization for westbound and eastbound traffic on State Route 120 turning onto Wamble Road. The left-turn channelization would include asymmetrical widening with a centerline shift to the south. The improvements would include widening the intersection and drainage work throughout the project limits. The project is located in Stanislaus County, on State Route 120, east of the City of Oakdale.



WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment with the incorporation of mitigation measures. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a public hearing.
