Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the environmental review process for the Springtown Open Space Phase 1 Project. The Local Development Review (LDR) Program reviews land use projects and plans to ensure consistency with our mission and state planning priorities. The following comments are based on our review of the October 2024 MND.

Please note this correspondence does not indicate an official position by Caltrans on this project and is for informational purposes only.

Project Understanding

The proposed project consists of Phase 1 of the Springtown Open Space Concept Plan and would include the development of a 4-6-acre community park and new parking lot with approximately 20 vehicle spaces. The proposed project would also include four pickleball courts/two tennis courts, a half-basketball court, and an 18-hole disc golf course. The proposed project would result in the disturbance of approximately 9 acres within the former Springtown Golf Course and Marlin Pound Neighborhood Park.

Construction-Related Impacts

Project work that requires movement of oversized or excessive load vehicles on State roadways requires a transportation permit that is issued by Caltrans. To apply, please visit Caltrans Transportation Permits ([link](#)).
