Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project is located within the City's Waste Water Treatment Facility and includes construction of: 1) a new 800 SF Bio-Solids Dryer Building which would be constructed in the same footprint as the existing Bio-Solids Dryer Building; 2) a new 5,000 SF Bio-Solids Storage Building, which would be constructed on the concrete pad of the now decommissioned secondary biofilters; and 3) and installation of a solar PV system which would consist of two modules of 6,250 and 10,850 SF each.

The parcel address is 101 West Cypress Street, the Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) is 008-020-07, and the site is located within the California Coastal Zone.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The proposed project is located within the 100-foot buffer of a rare plant community - Coastal Prairie Scrub. The project proposes to remove invasive ice plant mat from the coastal prairie plant community as mitigation for potential impacts. Project also proposes to remove invasive plants from the WWTF more generally.

The proposed project is within the 100-foot buffer of a pelagic cormorant cliff nesting area. The MND proposes completion of all work during non bird nesting season or perform bird nesting survey by a qualified biologist.

No cultural resources were found on the site although a cultural resource survey was completed. The MND proposes tribal monitoring during earth moving activities and standard mitigations if cultural resources or human remains are discovered during construction.

During construction hazardous spill could occur from vehicles and the MND proposes spill procedures and equipment.

The project has the potential to impact stormwater during construction and the MND requires preparation of a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan.
