

Project Description:	The project consists of the construction and operation of chloramination disinfection facilities at the existing Joaquin Ranch Pump Station.
Project Location – Identify street address and cross streets or attach a map showing project site (preferably a USGS 15' or 7 1/2' topographical map identified by quadrangle name):	The Project is located on District-owned property at 42581 Vineyard Parkway, which is situated along Vineyard Parkway near the intersection of Vineyard Parkway and Whitaker Way, southwest of Interstate 15, northeast of Murrieta Creek, in the City of Murrieta, in Riverside County, California.

This Initial Study was completed in accordance with the Lead Agency's Guidelines for Implementing the California Environmental Quality Act. 
