



# THORNTON WATER TANK RECOAT & REHABILITATION

## Project Description

### **Project Location:**

8600 Mokelumne Ave. See attached Vicinity Map.

### **Project Justification:**

The Thornton water tank, is a welded steel water tank located at 8600 Mokelumne Ave in Thornton, California. The tank was constructed in 2008 providing a nominal capacity of 230,000 gallons (0.23 million gallons).

As the tank being is older than fifteen years and the health of the water, the inside of the tank needs re-coating. Additionally in 2018, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) upgraded their requirements for safety affecting ladders, rails, gates, man ways & other tank appurtenances.

### **Scope of Work:**

The project will consist of:

1. Recoating and rehabilitating Thornton Water Tank inside and outside per current AWWA standards for coatings of above ground tanks.
2. Upgrading key features of the tank to meet current OSHA and American Water Works Association (AWWA) standards.

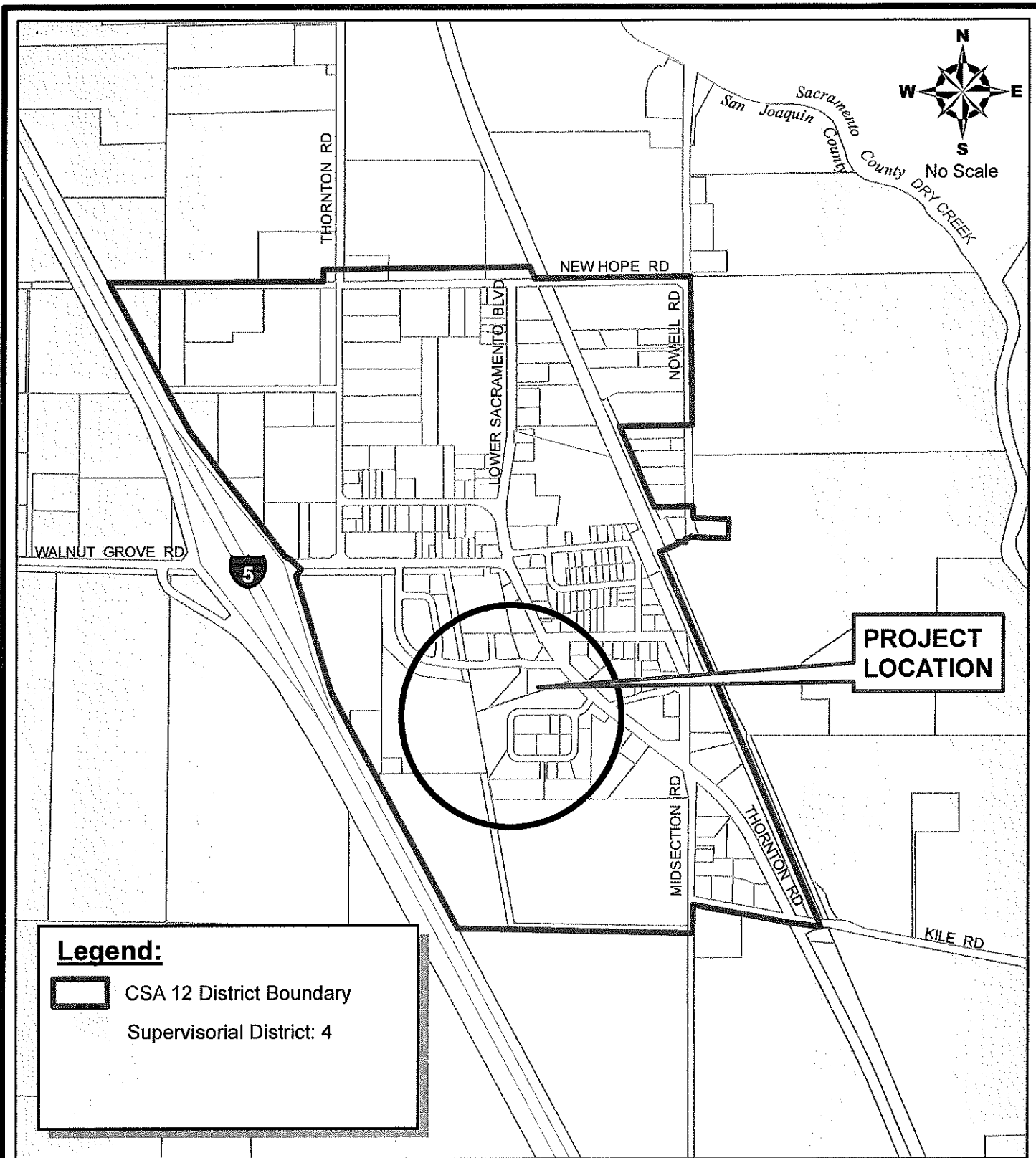
### **Environmental Setting:**

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes**.

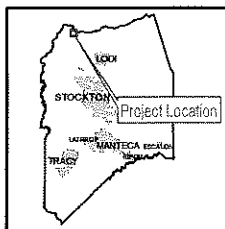
**There are many large trees adjacent to the project area.** Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15<sup>th</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **Beneficiaries:**

The project will see extend the tank's service life and ensure worker safety compliance with updated regulations. The public will benefit from the enhanced water quality.
