**Project Title:** King Buoy (Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ELD-49959-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Lake Tahoe, in the County of El Dorado, State of California; Latitude 39.024832° North, Longitude 120.118856° West; 8551 Meeks Bay Avenue, Tahoma, CA 96142.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number ELD-49959-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Gregory King.

The project consists of the placement of one (1) new mooring buoy in Lake Tahoe, offshore of the same parcel, by means of a barge mounted crane which will lower the anchor block, with chain and buoy attached, to the lakebed.



**Reasons why project is exempt:** **Class 3** because the project includes placement of one new mooring buoy (small structure). **Class 4** because the project will result in only minor alterations to the land and water where no removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees is involved.
