Project Title: Artois 333 (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. GLE-51262-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Wilson Creek, in the County of Glenn, State of California; Latitude 39.652078° North, Longitude 122.276952° West; 5783 County Road C, Orland, CA 95963.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number GLE-51262-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Jedessa Partners.

The project consists of clearing accumulated flood and storm debris, emergent vegetation, and human placed rubbish from the channel of Wilson Creek to facilitate storm water flows and minimize continued bank erosion and flooding.

Categorical Exemption. Type – Class (1, and 4); California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections (15301, 15304)

Reasons why project is exempt: **Class 1** because this project involves maintenance of an existing topographical feature (Wilson Creek stream channel). **Class 4** because the removal of accumulated aggregate, storm flow deposited debris and emergent vegetation constitutes a minor alteration to the land that does not involve the removal of health, mature, scenic trees.
