Project Description: The property owner, Orange County Rescue Mission, is seeking a Planning Application, PA23-0145, for the establishment of equine shade structures for its existing 13 horses at an existing church/seminary/educational facility. The project consists of the installation of fourteen (14) prefabricated equine shade structures (13 stalls for horses and 1 stall for track and feed), two (2) wash racks connected to the prefabricated equine shade structures, two (2) round training pens, one (1) training arena, one (1) hay storage shed, and one (1) trash bin for manure storage. The project will also include a 50 feet x 10 feet x 12 feet deep mulch basin, used to filter, and treat the greywater produced by the two (2) wash racks. Best Management Practices will be included as part of project construction. The proposed equine facilities shall be utilized by the existing residents/participants of the Orange County Rescue Mission.
