Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

In July 2021, California Governor Gavin Newsom signed into law Senate Bill (SB) 156 to create an open-access middle-mile network to bring equitable high-speed broadband service to all Californians. The lack of available middle-mile broadband infrastructure has been a major issue in connecting California's unserved and underserved communities. The statewide open-access middle-mile network included in SB 156 is a foundational investment to ensure every Californian has access to broadband Internet service that meets the connectivity needs of today, and well into the future. This project intends to support in providing critical statewide broadband infrastructure to enhance access to and increase the affordability of high-speed internet for all Californians.

Reasons why project is exempt:


The proposed scope of work as described is exempt from CEQA. Senate Bill 156 added Sec. 21080.51 to the California Public Resources Code which statutorily exempts linear broadband deployment within 30 feet of existing rights-of-way. Work would include the installation of subsurface broadband conduit and fiber, the installation of network repeater hubs at approximately 50-mile intervals, as well as the installation of vaults (Pull, Splice, and Buried) at various locations.
