NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

An Environmental Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration for the **Burnt Ranch Estates Community Water System Improvement Project** is now available for public review. The project consists of replacement of two water tanks, replacement of all water transmission lines, installation/replacement of water meters, and potential future work to increase resilience of the system. The project is located in the Burnt Ranch Estates, on APNs 008-790-003-000 and 008-800-005-000, and is surrounded by national forest land on all sides but to the north, which abuts private property.

The review period to submit written comments on the Mitigated Negative Declaration began November 20, 2024 and ends on December 18, 2024.
