Project Description: The Applicant proposes to construct and operate a 12-vessel arsenic treatment system at their Del Monte Well 4 site which includes a 60,000-gallon backwash tank, and a 299 square foot chemical building. Well 4 will also be reactivated and a replacement pump station will be built on the existing water facility site. There will be no expansion of the existing site.

Public Agency Approving the Project: State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board)

This is to advise that the State Water Board has issued a domestic water supply permit amendment for the above-described Project on November 19, 2024. A record of approval for the Project is available to the general public at the State Water Board, Division of Drinking Water district office listed above.
