Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Project is the consolidation of Stanislaus Union School District (SUSD) service area (Water System No. CA5000249) with the City of Modesto, through an extension of city water service within the boundaries of the approved Water Master Plan. The Project will construct a total of approximately 12,000 linear feet of 12-inch potable water pipeline along Tully Road; Kiernan Avenue; and Dale Road. The Project will extend from the existing dead-end 12-inch potable water main along Tully Road, approximately 700 feet south from the Tully Road and Kiernan Avenue intersection. The Project will install 13 new fire hydrants along Kiernan Avenue and a pipeline extension for water service to Stanislaus Elementary School beneath Kiernan Avenue using jack and bore tunneling between the new water main in Kiernan Avenue and the southwestern corner of the school parcel in the vicinity of the school's existing water meter.

Mitigation measures are proposed to reduce potentially significant impacts to less than significance for:

1. Aesthetics - MM AES-01: Construction Lighting Plan and MM AES-02: Coordination with Private Landowners.
2. Agriculture - MM AG-01: Buffer and Setback Guidelines.
3. Air Quality - MM AQ-01: Dust Control and Construction Emissions Reductions.
4. Biological Resources - MM BIO-01: Pre-construction Bird & Wildlife Clearance Surveys, Training, Monitoring, and Inspections.
5. Cultural Resources - MM CUL-01: Worker Environmental Awareness Training & MM CUL-02: Cultural Resources Discovery Protocol. MM CUL-03: Appropriate Handling of Human Remains.
6. Energy - MM EN-01: Idling Regulation for On-Road Diesel-Fueled Equipment.
7. Geology and Soils - MM GEO-01 through GEO-11: Implement Recommendations of the Geotechnical Engineer.
8. Hazardous Materials - MM HAZ-01: Coordination with Stanislaus Union School District and MM HAZ-02: Implement an Approved Hazardous Materials Manifest and Plan.
9. Hydrology and Water Quality - MM HYDRO-01: Comply with the Local SWPPP Requirements and MM HYDRO-02: Implement Stormwater BMPs throughout Project Construction.
10. Noise - MM NOI-01: Reduce Construction Noise to Appropriate Levels.
11. Public Services - MM PUB-01: Coordinate with Local Agencies for Traffic Control.
12. Traffic - MM TRAF-01: Implement an Approved Traffic Control Plan.
13. Utilities and Service - SC UTL-01: Implement an Approved Waste Management Plan During Construction.
