Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Project purpose is to replace the original floating boat dock and improve access to an existing motorized boat ramp on Anderson Creek near its confluence with the Sacramento River. The project involves removing approximately 500 cubic yards of vegetation and other accumulated material from Anderson Creek, installing a pre-fabricated dock and gangway, improving the entrance road, creating ADA-compliant parking spaces, and providing temporary or permanent restroom facilities.

Name of Public Agency Approving Project:

This is to advise that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 29 April 2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board considered the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration adopted on 5 February 2025 by Western Shasta Resource Conservation District, the lead agency for the Project.
