Project Title: State Route 108 Tuolumne Culvert Rehabilitation Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0145-R4)


Project Location: The Project will occur on a 0.77-mile segment of State Route 108, approximately 2.8 miles east of the community of Dardanelle in Tuolumne County, between Post Mile 55.41 and Post Mile 56.18, which travels over five tributaries to the Middle Fork Stanislaus River. The Project Area is within Sections 28 of Township 6 North, Range 20 East, Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian.

Project Description: The Project involves the replacement of culvert facilities at five (5) Locations, repaving of the road-cuts at each Location, rock slope protection, and restoration seeding/replanting within disturbed areas, between Post Mile 55.41 and Post Mile 56.18.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 4/6/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
