The project is located along a private road, between Lyons Valley Road and Skye Valley Road, approximately 2,000 feet south of the Lyons Valley Road / Private Road intersection on property owned by the City of San Diego Public Utilities Department. 32.7262, -117.6937

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The road needs immediate emergency repair and replacement work to restore vehicle and emergency responder access, stabilize the slope, and to prevent any further erosion or complete loss of this section of road. This emergency repair project will replace an approximately 20-foot-long segment of 48-inch diameter CMP with 48-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe, install new concrete headwalls on both sides of the road, backfill the area of slope failure to restore the natural grade, and install a new paved road surface where the road has collapsed.
