Project Title: Woodruff Creek and Tributaries to Woodruff Creek Crossing Replacement Project (Notification of Streambed Alteration Amendment, No. EPIMS-SMO-30009-R3).

Project Location (San Mateo County): The Woodruff Creek and Tributaries to Woodruff Creek Crossing Replacement Project (Project) is located at unnamed tributaries to Woodruff Creek, in the County of San Mateo, State of California; Section 7, Township 7S, Range 3W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map, Mindego Hill; Assessor's Parcel Number 078210390.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed an Amendment to Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification No. EPIMS-SMO-30009-R3, associated with 1600-2020-0152-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Pacific Gas & Electric Company, as represented by Craig Geldard.

The purpose of the Project Amendment is to remove and replace a failing culvert along a Pacific Gas & Electric Company maintenance road at an unnamed tributary to Woodruff Creek.

Person or Public Agency Carrying Out Project: Pacific Gas & Electric Company

Reasons why the project is exempt: The Project will make minor alterations to land by removing and replacing one failed stream crossing, installing rock slope protection, erosion control, and revegetating exposed soils. In addition, the Project will replace an existing structure where the new structure is located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.
