DE VRIES ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Project Description

Project Location:

De Vries Road: Thornton Road to State Route 12. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

Project Justification:

De Vries Road, formerly known as Telegraph Road, was originally constructed in 1937 with a structural section consisting of 0.17 feet (2 inches) of asphalt concrete (AC) over 0.5 feet (6 inches) of aggregate base (AB).

In 2000, the roadway was resurfaced with 0.25 feet (3 inches) of asphalt concrete over a pavement reinforcing fabric and widened by 4 feet on each side from Thornton Road to Armstrong Road, resulting in a 32-foot-wide roadway to accommodate a bicycle route. The roadway has been maintained through periodic chip seals, with the most recent application completed in 2024.

The project limits exhibit high amount of transverse and longitudinal cracking; a medium amount of block cracking; and a low amount of alligator, rutting, and weathering.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

1. Resurfacing existing roadway with 0.25 feet Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A).
2. Repairing pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.50 feet HMA (Type A).
3. Widening existing roadway from Armstrong Road to State Route 12 (from 24 feet to 32 feet).
4. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50 feet or to conform.
5. Adjusting Existing frame(s) and cover(s) of monuments and utilities to finished grade.
6. Replacing traffic signal loops at intersection of State Route 12 and De Vries Road.
7. Replenishing 6 foot wide shoulder backing 2 feet (8%) and 4 feet to conform existing.
8. Paving Driveways (Type D and E).
9. Removing existing thermoplastic striping and pavement markings exist within the project limits.

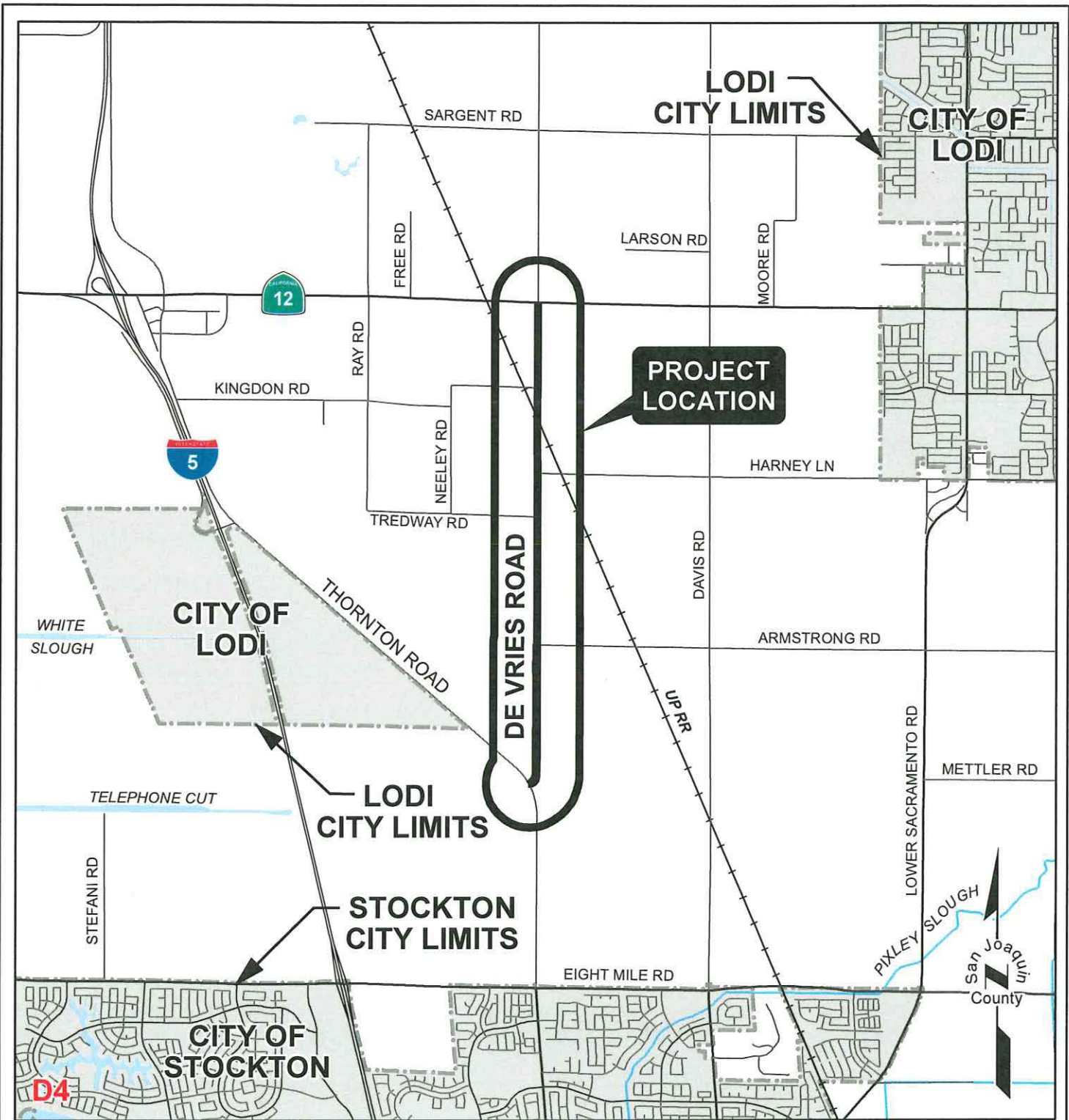
Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes.**

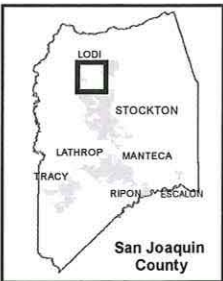
There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
