NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO CEQA

WHAT IS PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is proposing to perform drainage and safety improvements on Interstate 5 between Post Miles 58.0 and 67.019 in Shasta County and Post Miles 0.0 to 2.7 in Siskiyou County. The purpose of the project is to restore the facility to a state of good repair so that the roadway would be in a condition that requires minimal maintenance.

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

Caltrans and the FHWA have prepared a Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Flume Creek CAPM Project. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Draft IS/MND and of its availability for you to review. The Draft IS/MND is being circulated for public and agency review in accordance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines.
