The project site was historically used by the National Guard Armory, and vehicle and tank maintenance were conducted on the site. A Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) conducted in 2023 recommended evaluation of current subsurface environmental conditions. A Phase II ESA subsequently conducted to collect soil, groundwater, and soil vapor samples recommended additional environmental assessment and/or soil removal action. Recommended mitigation measures include the following:

1) Prepare and implement a soil removal action plan for additional investigation and/or removal of soil with elevation contamination levels; 2) Conduct additional soil gas sampling to confirm if detected contamination may cause an excessive vapor intrusion risk to the proposed school development or install a chemical resistant vapor barrier to mitigate the potential vapor intrusion concern; and 3) Prepare and implement a soil and groundwater management plan to address handling and management of impacted soil and/or groundwater that could be potentially be encountered during construction activities.
