

**RESOLUTION NO. 1418**

**MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS RELATED TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO FILE A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE RIO LINDA HIGH SCHOOL FENCING PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Twin Rivers Unified School District (District) is committed to maintaining and improving school facilities to ensure safe, functional, and sustainable learning environments for students and staff; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rio Linda High School Fencing Project (Project) was board approved on April 16, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project involves the installation of a new ornamental gate at the staff parking lot, new chain link fence in the northwest corner of the campus, and additional gates and fencing in the baseball-softball complex; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code, Section 21000 et seq.) and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 California Code of Regulations, Section 15000 et seq.) require public agencies to evaluate the environmental impacts of proposed projects before approving them; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under one or more applicable exemptions as set forth in the CEQA Guidelines, as described below:

1. **Class 11 Exemption (Section 15311)**: Applies to the construction or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or industrial facilities, such as small parking lots, signs, or similar structures; and/or
2. **Class 14 Exemption (Section 15314)**: Applies to minor additions to schools that do not increase student capacity by more than 25% or ten classrooms; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no evidence of any unusual circumstances that would preclude the use of these categorical exemptions, and there are no significant environmental impacts under the "common sense exemption" of CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), which applies where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility of a significant environmental effect; and

**WHEREAS**, District staff will file a Notice of Exemption (**Exhibit A**) with the Sacramento County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse in compliance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15062.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Twin Rivers Unified School District in Sacramento County, California, hereby issues this resolution that determines, declares, and resolves as follows:

1. The Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to the applicable exemptions listed above.
2. The Project was board approved on April 16, 2024.
3. The Project is as described in the scope above.
4. The District considered whether the Project would have significant impact on the environment and determined that no such impact exists based on its review and analysis.
5. The District's Superintendent or designee thereof is directed to file the Notice of Exemption from CEQA consistent with this resolution, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, with any and all appropriate public agencies or entities, subject only to minor, non-substantive revisions, if necessary.
