Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Re-activate Courtrooms that had been temporarily repurposed for office uses, as well as the remodel of other court related spaces at floors 2, 4 and 5. The work includes demolition and construction of new walls, ceilings, flooring, lighting, plumbing systems, modifications to the existing heating-ventilation-air-conditioning systems, and modifications to the fire alarm /fire sprinkler systems. Accessibility upgrades will remodel some public restrooms to create larger accessible toilet stalls. The magnitude of the work will also require that asbestos containing materials be addressed. There are no exterior site modifications.
