Project Description

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) proposes to implement the Kirkham Street Neighborway on Kirkham Street between 19th Avenue and La Playa Street. Neighborways are residential streets that are preferred neighborhood bicycling and walking routes. They are designed to give people and families, young, and old, a safer opportunity to use other transportation options like walking and



bicycling to access local and neighborhood destinations. Neighborways implement traffic calming tools to improve street safety on already low-stress streets; they are designed with pedestrians and bicyclists in mind, but do not prohibit vehicle access. The SFMTA has defined a Neighborway Traffic Safety Design Toolkit consisting of design treatments to achieve the desired traffic speeds, vehicle volumes, and intersection safety. At select locations along Kirkham Street, the project would install speed cushions, painted safety zones or continental crosswalks, and convert existing two-way stop-controlled intersections to four-way stop-controlled intersections.

Determination

The City and County of San Francisco decided to carry out or approve the project on June 21, 2024, when the City Traffic Engineer approved the project. The date of approval action posting on the Planning Department’s website was October 22, 2024. The project was officially approved on November 22, 2024, when no appeal of the statutory exemption was filed during the 30-day appeal period. 
