Within existing Visalia Parkway right-of-way from 1,200 feet west of Stonebrook Street to 600 feet east of Court Street, within the City limits of the City of Visalia.

This project will extend the north half of Visalia Parkway from 1,200 feet west of Stonebrook Street to 600 feet east of Court Street. All work will be within the present-day public right-of-way. The street extension will provide a total of two travel lanes, Class 3 bike routes, and will also consist of repairing miscellaneous damaged concrete structures such as curbs, gutters, drain inlets and ramps. Impacted ramps will be upgraded to be in ADA compliance and existing manholes and valve boxes will be adjusted to grade. All construction work will be within public right of way.
