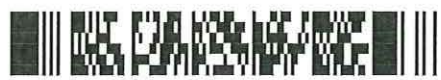

# GRAHAM ROAD AND PEARL ROAD RESURFACING 2025

## Project Description

### **Project Location:**

**Graham Road and Pearl Road:** Jahant Road to North End; Peltier Road to Collier Road. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

### **Project Justification:**

The original 18-foot-wide roadway of Graham Road was constructed by Road Maintenance in 1975 with prime coat over 6 inches of aggregate base (AB). The existing roadway has been maintained with periodic chip seals with the most recent chip seal in 2019. The original 18-foot-wide roadway of Pearl Road was constructed by Road Maintenance in 1971 with prime coat over 6 inches of aggregate base. The existing roadway has been maintained with periodic chip seals with the most recent chip seal in 2019.

The existing pavement has some transitional, longitudinal, and high edge cracking throughout the project limits. The existing roadway has a rough ride quality as well.

### **Scope of Work:**

The project will consist of:

1. Resurfacing existing roadway (18 feet wide) with 0.25 feet Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A).
2. Repairing pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.25 feet HMA (Type A).
3. Replenishing 4-foot-wide Shoulder Backing: 2 feet (8%) and 2 feet to conform.
4. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50 feet or to conform.
5. Constructing 8-foot HMA (Type A) driveways.
6. Removing and replacing one of the 18-inch corrugated metal pipe (CMP) cross pipe 0.34 miles north of Collier Road on Graham Road.

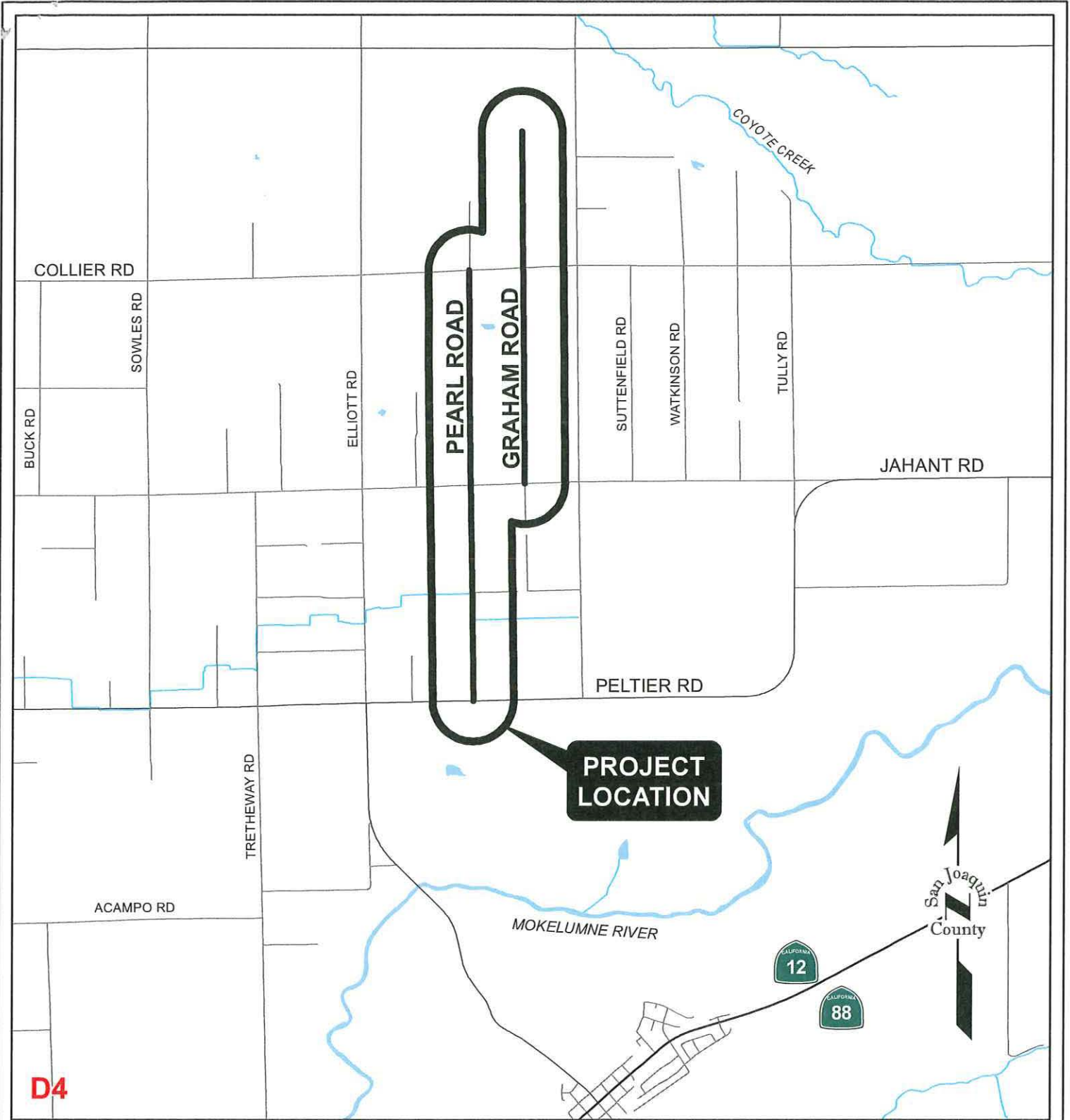
### **Environmental Setting:**

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes.**

**There are many large trees adjacent to the project area.** Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15<sup>th</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

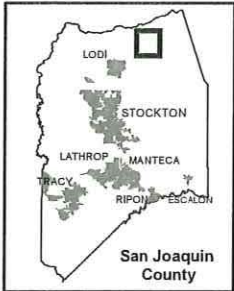
### **Beneficiaries:**
