Project proposal includes a revision to the previously approved Conditional Use Permit to construct a new galvanizing line within an existing structure with an approximate expansion of 9,000 square feet to accommodate new equipment; and a new push pull pickle line wholly within an existing structure at the California Steel Industries site.

All potential impacts have been thoroughly evaluated and have been deemed to be neither individually significant nor cumulatively considerable in terms of any adverse effects upon the region, the local community or its inhabitants.

The project modifications are not expected to generate adverse impacts to any environmental topic areas evaluated within the Initial Study. The project modifications include stationary emission sources that are a source of air emissions. However; because of the requirements to use BACT plus provide emission offsets, the project modifications, in combination with the previous project, will result in less than significant impacts. Therefore, no significant adverse air quality impacts are expected either individually or cumulatively.
