

**Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:**

The Scope of Work includes repairing and refurbishing the building's electrical and low voltage, information technology, telecommunication systems, interior finishes, signage, bookshelves, and furniture. The refurbished library would include interior upgrades to the customer service desk; adult reading, teen, and children areas; express-service self-checkout machines; public access computers; Wi-Fi internet access; and regrading the path of travel from the parking lot to the building entrance to meet current Americanswith Disabilities Act accessibility standards.
