**Project Title:** Stillwater Creek Tributary Remediation Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-55529-R1)

**Project Location:** The Project is located on a tributary to Stillwater Creek at T31N, R04W, section 1 of the Enterprise 7.5-minute United States Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle, Shasta County Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 111-060-009-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-55529-R1 pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Olin Burgoyne.

The Project is intended to remediate damages incurred to fish and wildlife resources resulting from the unauthorized activities, which include diversion, obstruction, and change or use of material from within bed, channel, and banks of the tributary to Stillwater Creek. Activities include removal of concrete debris and earthen fill, recontouring bed and banks, and restoring natural streamflow within the tributary to pre-violation conditions.
