Project Title: TRINITY ALPS FARMS, INC (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 460 LOWER RD, in Trinity County.

County: Trinity County

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Professions Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a cannabis Microbusiness license.

Project Activities: The proposed project is a microbusiness with cultivation, manufacturing, and non-storefront retail activities located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 009-440-023-00. The project will cultivate up to 10,000 square feet (sf) of mature outdoor canopy, a type 6 mechanical non-solvent license to make hash and rosin, and non-storefront retail that will deliver to event approximately twice a year. Water will be provided from a permitted well and pump diversion, energy will be provided through Trinity Public Utility District with three low-emission backup generators, and a permitted septic will be used for the Project's wastewater needs.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is consistent with the local jurisdiction community plan and/or zoning designations. CEQA mandates that the project is consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. The project activity fits within the parameters included in CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 and the activity does not require additional CEQA analysis.
