Project Title: Cucamonga Basin No. 6, 7 and 8 Routine Maintenance Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0240-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino): The Cucamonga Basins No. 6, 7, and 8 Routine Maintenance Project (Project) is located within Cucamonga Basins No. 6, 7, and 8, tributary to Cucamonga Channel and ultimately the Santa Ana River. The three basins are located within of the City of Upland, San Bernardino County, California; Latitude 34.129231⁰ and Longitude -117.635128⁰ .

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2019-0240-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, San Bernardino County Flood Control District.

The Project consists of on-going maintenance within Cucamonga Basins No. 6, 7, and 8. The maintenance activities covered under this Agreement include: mechanized clearing; hand thinning of vegetation and repair of existing structures, including riprap, concrete, and pile and wire.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on January 15, 2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
