

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND  
NOTICE OF REDWOOD VALLEY COUNTY WATER DISTRICT PUBLIC HEARING  
FOR THE INFRASTRUCTURE AND WATER RESILIENCY UPGRADES PROJECT**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that pursuant to the State of California Public Resources Code and Section 15072 of the State Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Redwood Valley County Water District (RVCWD) hereby gives notice to responsible agencies, trustee agencies, interested parties, and the general public that the RVCWD intends to adopt Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Infrastructure and Water Resiliency Upgrades Project. In accordance with CEQA, the RVCWD is circulating the IS/MND for public comment. The RVCWD will then consider and make a decision on the adequacy of the IS/MND and the merits of the proposed project.

**PROJECT TITLE:** Infrastructure and Water Resiliency Upgrades Project

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The Site is located approximately 0.4 miles north of the City of Ukiah within unincorporated Mendocino County on the 31-acre parcel identified by APN: 170-170-06 and an approximately 14-acre portion of APN: 170-180-10.

**DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:** The RVCWD proposes to develop up to two new water supply wells and connect the well(s) to existing water system infrastructure in order to establish a reliable water source for customers of the RVCWD (Project). This would involve drilling and developing up to two wells to provide a minimum combined 300 gallons per minute and installing water lines to connect the proposed wells to existing water system infrastructure at the Site belonging to the Millview County Water District (MCWD).

**PROJECT DETERMINATION:** Based on the findings of the IS/MND, it has been determined that the Project would not have a significant effect upon the environment with mitigation incorporated. The Project is not known to contain any significant hazardous waste contamination under Section 65965.5 of the Government Code.

**WHAT WILL HAPPEN:** The RVCWD will receive a staff presentation, consider public comments and decide to either adopt, not adopt, or modify the IS/MND.
