

RESOLUTION NO. 1429

MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS RELATED TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO FILE A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE NORTHWOOD ELEMENTARY UNIVERSAL TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Twin Rivers Unified School District (“District”) is committed to maintaining and improving school facilities to ensure safe, functional, and sustainable learning environments for students and staff; and

WHEREAS, the Northwood Elementary Universal Transitional Kindergarten Project (“Project”) was board approved on to December 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Project involves modernizing and converting an existing portable building with a total of 1,440 square feet of usable space. The Project includes the removal of a wall that divides the building into two 720-square-foot spaces, transforming it into a single, open classroom. The updated classroom will feature a new restroom and be designed to provide a modern, age-appropriate learning environment tailored for transitional kindergarten students; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) (Pub. Resources Code, Section 21000 et seq.) and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 CCR Section 15000 et seq.) require public agencies to evaluate the environmental impacts of proposed projects before approving them; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under one or more applicable exemptions as set forth in the CEQA Guidelines, as described below:

1. **Class 1 Exemption (Section 15301)**: Applies to the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing facilities, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing; and/or
2. **Class 2 Exemption (Section 15302)**: Applies to the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity; and/or
3. **Class 14 Exemption (Section 15314)**: Applies to minor additions to schools that do not increase student capacity by more than 25% or ten classrooms.

WHEREAS, there is no evidence of any unusual circumstances that would preclude the use of these categorical exemptions, and there are no significant environmental impacts under the
