**Description of Project:** The City of Redding (City) proposes to improve pedestrian access in west Redding . The City would construct approximately 390 square feet of concrete sidewalk and a driveway ramp to extend the existing sidewalk. Work includes clearing, grinding, digging, and pouring concrete. Temporary traffic control may be required. The public will be notified of the project.

## Reasons why project is exempt:

Class 1 exemptions include the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing facilities, structures, or equipment involving negligible or no expansion of use. The project involves constructing less than 390 square feet of concrete sidewalk and driveway to extend existing sidewalk facilities. Areas of construction are currently used as a walkway and are covered by crushed gravel. There will be no trees removed, and the areas of construction are otherwise not environmentally sensitive. The project does not involve expansion of use. The project has no potential to have a significant effect on the environment.
