## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

CAL FIRE would provide funding to the Esselen Tribe of Monterey County to implement tribal wildfire resilience treatments to manage their ancestral lands in Monterey County. Treatments include mechanical and manual fuel reduction (i.e., shaded fuel break and thinning), cultural burning, pile burning, biomass/biochar utilization, and Cultural Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK) heritage oak care. These treatments aim to serve California Native American Tribes and advance wildfire resilience, forest health, and the cultural use of fire.
