

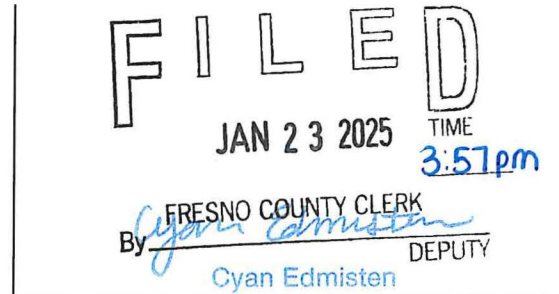

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The 2025-2027 Fresno County Road Improvement Program (RIP) is a multi-year road maintenance and construction program that provides a "roadmap" of anticipated revenues and expenditures on the Fresno County road system. The RIP identifies specific projects such as safety, pedestrian, bicycle, road, bridge, and other transportation-related projects. The RIP reflects the Department's implementation of the Board of Supervisors' policy direction to protect and improve the public investment in the 3,488-mile road system, and to provide for the safe and efficient movement of people and commodities throughout the County. The RIP identifies projects and maintenance programming levels the Department expects to deliver to the public through 2027. The RIP is a multi-year road maintenance and construction programming guide for planning and information purposes; therefore, each project identified in the RIP must undergo CEQA review prior to being constructed.

REASONS WHY THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT: This action is a Countywide multi-year maintenance and construction programming plan; therefore, it is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15262 *Feasibility and Planning Studies*. Additionally, this action is not considered a project by definition and is exempt from CEQA under Sections 15378(b)(2) & (b)(5) *Project*.

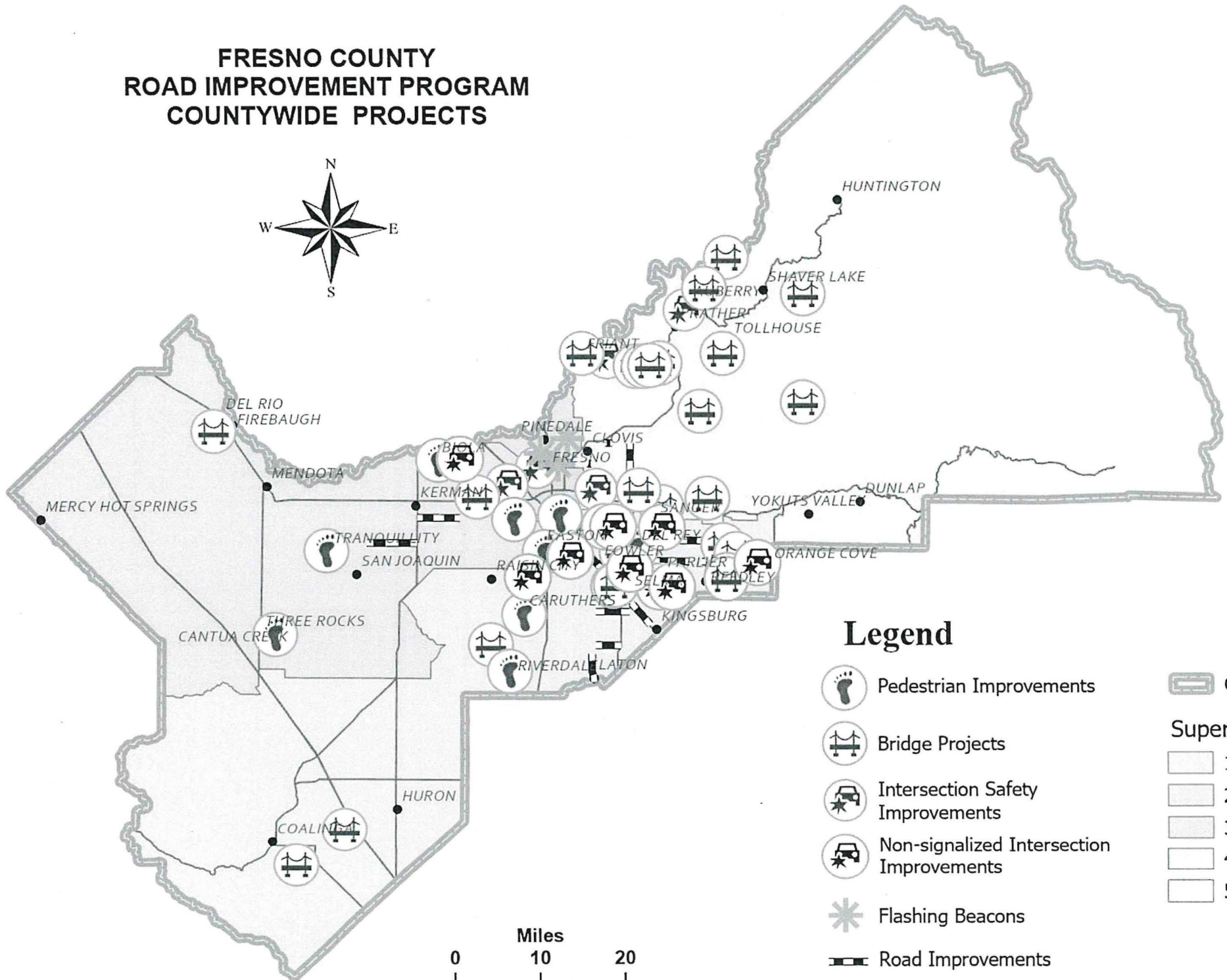
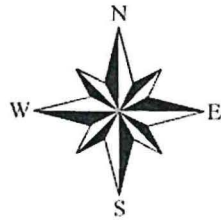

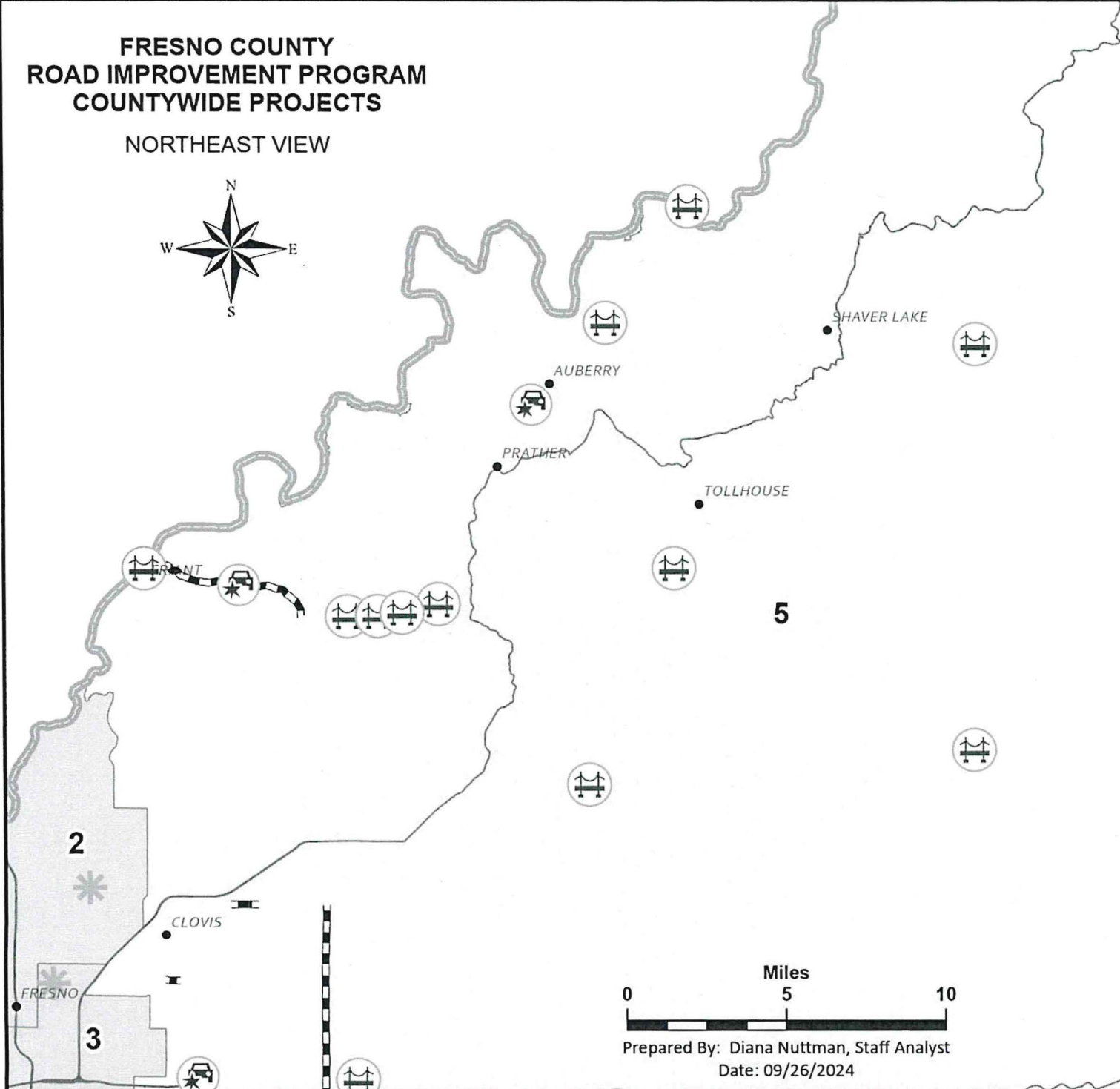

NORTHEAST VIEW

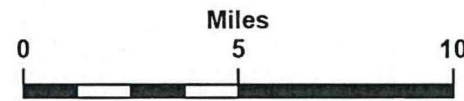
