The Mendocino County Resource Conservation District will construct a salmonid habitat enhancement project that restores channel complexity to a reach of the lower Mill Creek in the Navarro watershed. Installation of 3 large wood structures will enhance habitat and support salmonid populations by providing deep pools with woody cover in a reach that is lacking salmonid habitat.
