Project Title: Tahoe Donner Golf Course Bridge Replacement (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. NEV-52339-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Trout Creek, in the County of Nevada, State of California; Latitude 39.350947, Longitude -120.233827; 12850 Northwoods Boulevard, Truckee, CA 96161; Assessor's Parcel Number: 044-510-009-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number NEV-52339-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Tahoe Donner Association.

The project is limited to the replacement of a bridge over Trout Creek with a prefabricated bridge. The existing abutments will be removed and replaced with similar abutments within the same location. The bridge abutments would be installed using an excavator and skid steer to unearth the existing abutments and a concrete pump to install the new abutments. The existing irrigation pipeline would be relocated and attached to the bridge. Bank stabilization would be accomplished by grading back the existing bank where erosion has occurred and placing large rock to stabilize the bank.

Reasons why project is exempt: The project is class one (1) exempt because it consists of the repair, maintenance, and minor alteration of existing public or private structures and topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The project is class two (2) exempt because it consists of the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.
