**PROJECT TITLE:** Wildwood Water Service to Residence

**LOCATION:** Wildwood Canyon Park Property

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** This project will tap into the Yucaipa Valley Water District water main, install the service to state residence replacing the unreliable well system that currently serves the park. Service will include installation of water line, check valves, backflow device, water shut off, booster pump, other related plumbing and new electrical service to support the system. Most of the system will be installed within the disturbance footprint of existing roads. Approximately 250 feet will traverse natural open space.
