The Project would provide additional water storage capacity at the Clinton O. Nixon Treatment and Storage Facility and the VCWD service area. According to the 2021 Water Master Plan, the VCWD service area is deficient in storage by 4.84 MG and future deficiency would be 6.02 MG. The proposed Project includes the demolition of the existing carport, warehouse, district office, and associated foundations and pavement to construct up to two (2) above ground steel water reservoir tanks with a total storage capacity of 2.5 MG each on the existing Clinton O. Nixon Treatment and Storage Facility consisting of 2.7 acres. The reservoir tanks proposed at the Project site would be up to 108 feet in diameter and up to approximately 47 feet in total height. The reservoir tanks would be painted a solid, neutral color and would have a nonreflective surface.
