**Project Title:** Sutter Emergency Road Repair (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SUT-53568-R2)

**Project Location:** The project includes 9 different locations on the Snake River, Pleasant Grove Creek Canal, and multiple unnamed tributaries, in the County of Sutter, State of California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SUT-53568-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sutter County Developmental Services.

The project is limited to the removal and replacement of 9 culverts, including road repair and stormwater infrastructure repair, backfill of the release channel, the installation of new culverts, and the installation of a permanent crossing.

**Exempt Status:**

Categorical Exemption. Existing Facilities – Class 1 and 2; California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections 15301 and 15302

**Reasons why the Project is exempt:** Class 1 because the project includes rehabilitation of deteriorated or damaged structures and facilities to meet current standards of public health and safety. Class 2 because the project includes replacement of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity.
