Description of Project: The City of Redding (City) proposes to remove and replace approximately 48,775 square feet of flooring (combination of carpet tile, vinyl plank, and resilient stair treads). In addition, the existing wall base will be removed, disposed of and replaced with new material, and new metal transition strips shall be installed in designated locations. The project also includes moving and relocating or reinstalling all existing shelving and furniture.


Reasons why project is exempt: Class 1 exemptions include the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing facilities, structures, or equipment involving negligible or no expansion of use. The project is to replace flooring, replace existing wall base, install transition strips, and relocate or reinstall existing shelving and furniture. Old flooring and debris will be removed offsite for proper disposal. The project is a regular maintenance item and does not involve change of or expansion of use. Therefore, the project has no potential to have a significant effect on the environment and further environmental review is not required.
