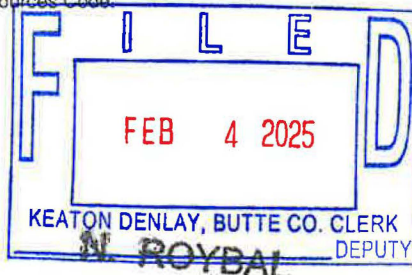

Cirby Creek Road Replacement
Avoidance and Minimization Measures

To avoid and minimize potential impacts to wildlife, the project will adhere to the following avoidance and minimization measures:

1. Prior to commencement, the project shall obtain the necessary authorizations issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and the Regional Water Quality Control Board.
2. The project will identify a designated biologist to monitor construction activities. The designated biologist will be onsite for the duration of in-channel construction and will monitor and analyze potential biological impacts of daily construction activities.
3. If project activities are planned to begin between February 15 and September 15, prior to project commencement, the designated biologist shall conduct a preconstruction survey for nesting and migratory birds. The survey shall be conducted no more than seven (7) days prior to start of work.
4. Prior to project commencement the designated biologist shall conduct a preconstruction survey for special-status species. If special-status species are observed within the project site construction activities shall be paused, and species shall be allowed to leave the area on its own volition.
5. All temporarily disturbed vegetative sites shall be revegetated by seeding with a native seed mix.
