The Local Development Review (LDR) Program reviews land use projects and plans to ensure consistency with our mission and state planning priorities. The following comments are based on our review of the February 2025 draft MND.

Project Understanding

The proposed project includes the construction of two double-sided electronic billboards at the southeast corner of Guadalupe Parkway and West Mission near US 101 and at 1404 Mabury Rd near State Route 87 (SR 87). The proposed sign would be visible to travelers along SR 87 and US 101.
