Caltrans proposes replacing the double white striping (detail 44B) with a single white stripe (detail 43A) separating the HOV lane from the general purpose lanes. The project will also grind and replace a 4-foot wide section of hot mix asphalt along the lane lines to avoid future pavement unraveling.
