NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

County of Monterey (County) has completed the Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the proposed Prunedale Roundabout Project. The Draft IS/MND found the following environmental factors to be less than significant with mitigation incorporated: Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Noise, and Tribal Cultural Resources.

APPLICANT: County of Monterey

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located at the intersection of Castroville Boulevard and San Miguel Canyon Road in unincorporated Monterey County, California.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed project includes the replacement of the existing one-way stop-controlled intersection located at San Miguel Canyon Road and Castroville Boulevard with a single lane roundabout and the construction of associated roadway improvements, including installation of lighting, signing, retaining walls, and a temporary signalized intersection to address traffic control during construction.

HAZARDOUS WASTE/SUBSTANCES: The project site is not included on any of the lists enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
