Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project includes the replacement of the existing one-way stop-controlled intersection located at San Miguel Canyon Road and Castroville Boulevard with a single lane roundabout and the construction of associated roadway improvements, including installation of lighting, signing, retaining walls, and a temporary signalized intersection to address traffic control during construction.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

**Air Quality:** The project has the potential to expose sensitive receptors to short-term construction air emissions and to disturb asbestos containing material (ACM). Mitigation has been identified to reduce construction-related air emissions and risk associated with ACM.

**Biological Resources:** The project has the potential to disturb nesting migratory birds and native oak trees during construction activities. Mitigation has been identified to reduce potential impacts through a preconstruction nesting bird survey and implementation of avoidance buffers if birds are observed in the project area. Mitigation also requires replacement of removed trees.

**Cultural/Tribal Cultural Resources:** The project has the potential for inadvertent discovery of unknown cultural/tribal cultural resources. Mitigation has been identified to reduce impacts through implementation of proper protocol.

**Hazards and Hazardous Materials:** The project has the potential to disturb ACM and mitigation has been identified to reduce risk associated with ACM through proper testing, handling, and disposal techniques.

**Noise:** The project has the potential to increase short-term ambient noise levels during construction. Mitigation has been identified to reduce construction-related noise through best management practices.
