Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed Project includes the rehabilitation of the existing Llano Road Trunk pipeline, a critical wastewater collection facility, which carries approximately two thirds of the City's wastewater flow to the Laguna WTP. The existing pipeline is nearly 50 years old and must be rehabilitated to prevent failure of the system and/or more impactful actions that would be associated with replacement. The scope of the Project includes rehabilitation of approximately 8,170 linear feet (LF) of the 66-inch reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) trunk sewer. It also includes a conditions assessment of the existing manholes along the alignment and rehabilitation of the manholes as recommended at the conclusion of the condition assessment field investigation.

The IS/MND for the proposed Project identifies potentially significant impacts of the project related to air quality (odor concerns and fugitive dust), biological resources (special-status plants and birds, roosting bats, nesting birds, burrowing owl, California Tiger Salamander, Northwestern Pond Turtle, American Badger, riparian habitat, and wetlands), transportation and wildfire (impair adopted emergency procedures), cultural and tribal cultural resources (accidental discovery of unknown archaeological resources and/or human remains), geology and soils (accidental discovery of paleontological resources), hazards and hazardous materials (interfere with adopted emergency plan). Mitigation measures proposed in the Draft IS/MND include agency-identified measures to reduce fugitive dust and toxic air contaminant emissions (Bay Area Air Quality Mitigation measures proposed in the Draft IS/MND would reduce these impacts below the threshold of significance and include resource agency-identified measures to avoid impacts to air quality (BAAQMND 2022 CEQA Air Quality Guidelines), biological resources (pre-construction surveys, relocation plan, biological monitor, work windows), geology and soils, cultural, tribal cultural, and paleontological resources (archaeological training, tribal monitoring, compliance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15064.5(f)), hazards and hazardous materials, transportation and wildfire (traffic control plan).
